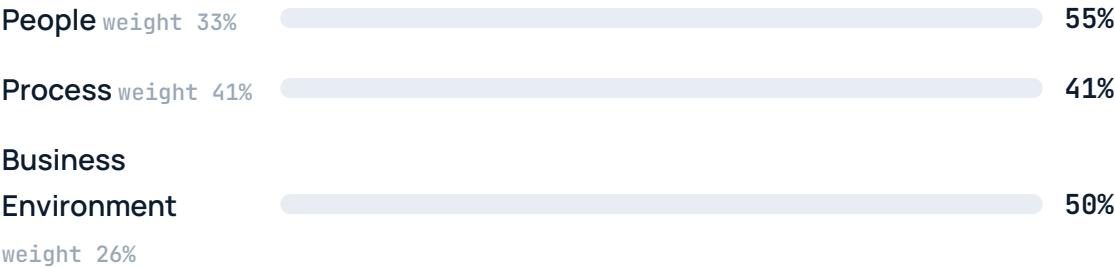

- Then **2.8.5 Create the schedule**: review the critical path and float from the network diagram.
